



# Days of F.I.R.E.

FERVENCY INTERCESSION RIGHTEOUSNESS EMPOWERMENT

**Each week we will be focusing on one letter of the word F.I.R.E. Let us endeavor to rekindle a fervency that leads to intercession. We must remember that effectual prayer flows from a righteous heart full of the Holy Spirit!**

## DAY PRAY THAT WE WILL . . .

1. Realize our need for fervent prayer. "Pray without ceasing" (I Thessalonians 5:17).
2. Commit to prayer. "Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints" (Ephesians 6:18).
3. Understand the urgency. "Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near" (Isaiah 55:6).
4. Zealous in relationships. "Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2).
5. Confess our faults. "Confess your faults one to another" (James 5:16).
6. Care for others. "... and pray one for another, that ye may be healed" (James 5:16).
7. Pray with fervency to avail much. "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:16).
8. Intercede for our cities. Nehemiah prayed for Jerusalem: "I pray, LORD God of heaven, ... please let Your ear be attentive and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of Your servant which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your servants" (Nehemiah 1:5-6, NKJV).
9. Intercede for our nations. Moses prayed: "Turn from Your fierce wrath, and relent from this harm to Your people. Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, Your servants.... So the LORD relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people" (Exodus 32:12-14, NKJV).
10. Intercede for world evangelism. "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" (Matthew 28:19).
11. Intercede for laborers. "Pray ye therefore the LORD of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest" (Matthew 9:38).
12. Intercede for the churches. Paul interceded for the Ephesians: "For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our LORD Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man" (Ephesians 3:14-16).
13. Intercede for our pastors. "Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in chains, that I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak" (Colossians 4:2-4, NKJV).
14. Intercede for revival. "And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance" (Acts 2:2-4).

## DAY PRAY THAT WE WILL . . .

15. Search our hearts. "Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts" (Psalm 139:23).
16. Cleanse our hearts. "Create in me a clean heart O God ..." (Psalm 51:10).
17. Renew a right spirit in us. "...and renew a right spirit within me" (Psalm 51:10).
18. Possess right motives. "The LORD shall judge the peoples; Judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to my integrity within me" (Psalm 7:8, NKJV).
19. Make right decisions. "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin" (James 4:17).
20. Put on Christ. "But put ye on the LORD Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof" (Romans 13:14).
21. Demonstrate righteousness. "My mouth shall tell of Your righteousness and Your salvation all the day, for I do not know their limits" (Psalm 71:15, NKJV).
22. Empowered by the Holy Ghost. "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth" (Acts 1:8, NKJV). Search our hearts. "Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts" (Psalm 139:23).
23. Empowered to witness. "And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the LORD Jesus: and great grace was upon them all" (Acts 4:33).
24. Empowered for the miraculous. "And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people" (Acts 6:8).
25. Empowered to do good works. "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him" (Acts 10:38).
26. Empowered with strength. "Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness" (Colossians 1:11).
27. Empowered with joy. "The joy of the LORD is your strength" (Nehemiah 8:10).
28. Empowered with assurance. "Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time" (I Peter 1:5).
29. Rejoice in prayers answered. "Rejoice evermore" (I Thessalonians 5:16).
30. Give thanks. "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (I Thessalonians 5:18).
